No soft copy through email will be accepted from candidate working in India.
- 3) No additional document(s)/certificate(s) will be accepted after submission of the application form.
- 4) Only applicants who are currently working abroad can submit a scanned copy of filled in application to e-mail: deanadm@vnit.ac.in; however they also need to send the hard copy by the courier, non receipt of the hard copy may result into non consideration of such application.
- 5) Institute reserves the right to limit the candidates to call for test / interview as per the requirement of the Institute.
- 6) To limit applicants to a reasonable numbers, the Institute has the right to set higher norms for scrutiny than minimum prescribed above. The areas of specialization and the post/level applied for will be taken into account while short listing, giving due consideration to the specific requirements of the individual departments.
