**Answer**: Yes, The institute has taken effective measures to prevent the brutal death of students resulting from ragging and inhuman treatment thereof.

Question: b) & c) If so the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regards?

Answer: Institute has taken following anti ragging mechanisms -

- Anti Ragging Committee is already exist in the institute to take care of all the matters related with ragging.
- Formation of Anti Ragging squad as security measures which comprises in Associate Dean (Hostel Affairs) as a Chairman, Wardens (i.e. Girls and Boys hostels), Assistant Registrar (Hostel) and Security Officer.
- Regular rounds of wardens in the hostel especially during night hours.
- Institute has appointed two psychological counselors / psychiatrist (on contract) who help students through counseling.
- A service of Counselors is provided to all students. Based on the information received (which is kept confidential) from the Counselors, student is kept under vigilance of the wardens / faculty mentors.
- Regular interaction with suspected students is take place.
- Guidance of such students through mentorship students mentorship program.
- Regular awareness programs by psychological counselors.
- Every year institute conducts remedial classes for weaker students/ slow learner / students as one of the reasons for suicide is continuous failure and hiding results from parents.

• To create the awareness amongst the students Anti ragging posters are also displayed in all hostels
