

NOTICE

Under the Student Exchange of MoU for Academic and Research Collaboration between VNIT and IIT Madras top 10% of the students (at the end of 6th semester) of VNIT, will be allowed to seek admission to direct Ph.D program of IITM, and enable them to pursue their 7th and 8th semester of their B.Tech. program at IITM.

Interested students (who are appearing in 6th semester in Summer 2019) are requested to submit their application in the prescribed format to the Dean (Acad.) on or before April 03, 2019. Eligibility of the students who submit the application will be finalized after the declaration of results of Summer-2019.

Admission of top 10% of BTech students of VNIT to Direct PhD programme at IITM

Salient Features / Norms for top 10% of B.Tech students of VNIT seeking admission to Ph.D programme at IITM

- a) Top 10% of the B.Tech students from other Institutions (which agree to participate in the programme) who are in their 3rd year will be eligible to apply for Direct Ph.D. This provision will be applicable to the institutes who enter into a specific MoU with IITM in this regard.
- b) Selected students will move to IIT Madras in the 4th year.
- c) Credits earned during first year of Ph.D programme at IIT Madras shall have equivalence to the credit needed for the 4th year of the B.Tech programme. The credits will be transferred to their parent institution to award B.Tech degree.
- d) The candidate would complete the comprehensive viva within 5 semesters after joining IIT Madras.
- e) The students selected for admission to Ph.D programme are eligible for HTRA for five years, after completing their first year of stay successfully at IIT Madras. Students from CFTIs having a CGPA of 8 and above, will be eligible for award of HTRA without the requirement of GATE. Students admitted from Non-CFTIs, are required to qualify in GATE for becoming eligible for the award of HTRA.
- f) If a student does not perform well in the courses at IIT Madras, the student will be transferred back to the parent institution along with credits earned.
- g) If a student is not found fit to continue in the Ph.D programme, he/she will be allowed to drop out any time after the 5th year, at which point the B.Tech. credits will be transferred to the parent institute.
