1 Preamble

Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology (VNIT) (formerly VRCE), Nagpur, is one of the first six Regional Engineering Colleges established under the scheme sponsored by the Government of India and the State Governments. The College was established in June 1960 and named after the eminent engineer, planner, and statesman of the country Bharat Ratna, Sir M. Visvesvaraya. Over the years, this Institution has gained recognition as an important National Institution in the field of Technical Education & research. Apart from imparting professional education at undergraduate and postgraduate levels, the Institute has been extending available expertise to various Govt./Semi-Govt. and private organizations through testing and consultancy works. The Institute also organizes short-term courses and seminars for the benefit of those in the profession. The Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology was enacted under NIT Act 29 of 2007 by Govt. of India and declared an Institute of National importance.

VNIT has a beautiful campus of about 214 acres near Ambazari Lake. All departments and laboratories are housed on the campus, which also offers hostel accommodation for students and residential accommodation for teaching and non-teaching staff. The campus has retained and increased its green cover, which is rich in flora and fauna and attracts bird watchers.

Institutional Vision

To contribute effectively to the national and international endeavor of producing quality human resources of a world-class standard by developing a sustainable technical education system to meet the changing technological needs of the country and the world, incorporating relevant social concerns and building an environment to create and propagate innovative technologies for the economic development of the nation.

2 Programs Offered

The institute offers four-year undergraduate programs in Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Computer Science Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Mining Engineering, Metallurgical & Materials Engineering, Chemical Engineering, and a five-year course in Architecture. In addition, the institute offers full-time (M. Tech) and Ph. D. programs. A three-year Ph.D. program under the QIP scheme is also offered in the Department of Electrical Engineering and Metallurgical & Materials Engineering. The laboratories in various departments have excellent research and testing facilities. The institute has acquired highly sophisticated equipment for various Departments, and new equipment has been added to various laboratories in recent years.

3 M. Tech. Programs

The Institute will offer the following full-time M. Tech. programs of two years duration (i.e., four semesters), as shown in Table -1, during the academic year 2024-25.

4 Eligibility Criteria

Table -2 provides details regarding the eligibility criteria for admission to various full-time M. Tech. Programs of two years duration conducted by the Institute.

NOTE:

i) In addition to the above, up to 5 seats (non-stipendiary) are available for sponsored candidates in all programs except Environmental Engineering. The seats under the sponsored category in Environmental Engineering are reserved for the Government of India, Ministry of Urban Development under the CPHEEO scheme.

(ii) Titles of degrees other than those mentioned in Table 2 are not acceptable as qualifying degrees, and **No equivalence certificate will be considered.**

5 Submission of Application Form for Admission to M. Tech. Programs

Group-A: GATE qualified candidates: Candidates fulfilling eligibility criteria (Degree and GATE paper) as specified in Table 2 and securing valid GATE score, i.e., GATE score more than or equal to the qualifying (cut-off) marks, are eligible for admission to the stipendiary seats in the respective programs.

All such candidates are required to register and submit their choices to the Centralized Counseling for M. Tech. Admissions (CCMT 2024) for common admissions to full-time M. Tech. programs. For details, visit <https://ccmt.admissions.nic.in/>.

Further, note that all these candidates will also be eligible to apply for the Institutional Spot Round (ISR) against vacancies after Phase-III (National Spot Round) of the CCMT 2024 schedule. These candidates need to submit separate online application forms to VNIT for participation in ISR.

Group-B: Non-GATE candidates: Candidates should have passed in qualifying degree as mentioned in Table 2 but did not qualify GATE exam or did not appear for the GATE examination are considered under the Group-B category. In case, the result of qualifying degree is awaited, provisional admission is permitted to a candidate subject to meeting the minimum qualifying degree requirements latest by September 30, 2024.

After all rounds for Group-A candidates, conducted by CCMT -2024 are completed, the institutional round of admissions will be carried out at VNIT-Nagpur for the vacant seats of VNIT, if any except for M.Tech. (Computer Science and Engineering) program. *** Group B candidates need not to apply for M.Tech. (Computer Science and Engineering) program.** Candidates of Group B will have to appear for a written test as per the schedule in Table 3. These candidates will not be eligible for the assistantship (stipend).

Group-C: Sponsored candidates: Candidates who fulfill eligibility criteria (Degree) as specified in Table 2.

Group-C1: Candidates recommended by various ministries of the Central as well as State Governments, Govt. R&D Organizations and Public Sector Undertakings.

Group-C2: Candidates from the industries and teachers from private institutions with qualified GATE scores.

Group-C3: Candidates from the industries and teachers from private institutions without qualified GATE scores or did not appear for the GATE examination.

(i) Group C candidates must have a minimum 2 years of full-time work experience in the relevant field in which admission is being sought after attaining the qualifying degree/certificate in a registered firm/company/industry/ educational and/or research institute/any Government Department or Government Autonomous organization. The candidate must submit the sponsorship cum experience certificate in the prescribed format along with the application form.

(ii) Group-C 3 candidates will have to appear for a written test per schedule: Table 3.

(iii) Candidates falling under the sponsored category will be prioritized as follows: 1. Group-C1, 2. Group-C 2 and 3. Group-C 3.

(iv) Up to 5 seats (non-stipendiary) are available for sponsored candidates in all programs except Environmental Engineering. (The Seats under sponsored category in Environmental Engineering are reserved for Govt. of India, Ministry of Urban Development under the CPHEEO scheme)

(v) If the number of eligible candidates under category Group—C 1 exceeds the number of seats, the merit list will be based on marks/CGPI obtained in the final year of the qualifying degree.

The candidate is required to pay a nonrefundable application fee of Rs 500/—online through VNIT's payment portal (Link: <https://pay.vnit.ac.in/home>). After payment, the candidate shall mention this VNIT Payment Ref. No in the application form and attach a printed copy of the receipt to the hard copy of the online application at the time of the spot round.

If a candidate is applying for multiple programs within the same department or across multiple departments, caution must be exercised when selecting the appropriate program and department.

Please also note that:

1. No Separate calls will be sent to candidates. They should attend the written test/admission as per the schedule given in this prospectus.
2. The candidates of Group B and C3 will be shortlisted on the basis of performance in the written test. The top scorer of the written test will be normalized to 100 and marks of other candidates will be scaled accordingly. Department can set a normalized cut-off. However, a normalized cut-off below 40% is not allowed.

8 Admission Procedure and Schedule for Institutional Round

After completion of all rounds for Group-A candidates conducted by CCMT 2024, further rounds of admissions shall be carried out at VNIT only for the vacant seats, if any, for the candidates of Group-A and candidates of Groups 'B' and 'C' as per the following schedule. Group 'A' candidates will be given priority over Group B candidates.

Venue & Date: Would be displayed on the website for all programs.

It is mandatory for all the candidates on the merit list to be present personally during the Admission Round

Documents/Certificates at the time of admission

(i) The candidates will have to produce all the following documents/certificates in original at the time of admission.

- a] Hardcopy of submitted online form signed by the candidate, with receipt of payment of Rs 500 application fee.
- b] GATE scorecard (For admission on GATE Merit)
- c] Qualifying Examination Degree Certificates
- d] Mark list/grade card of Qualifying Examination
- e] Transfer Certificate/ Institute leaving certificate/University Migration Certificate
- f] If (c), (d) & (e) are not applicable, Mark list /grade card of Pre-Qualifying Examination,

- h] Caste Certificate, as applicable for reserved category.

(For OBC candidates valid non-creamy layer certificate is essential. Maharashtra State reserved category candidates, validity certificate is essential from the competent Authority)

i] Disability certificate if applying for the PwD category.

J] Demand Draft *in favor of Director, VNIT, Nagpur, payable at Nagpur of required admission fees*, or Candidate can pay the fees on the spot in online mode as well.

Bring one set of attested photocopies of all the above certificates as applicable in the same order.

Please note that-

The candidate will have to be present personally for admission.

1. Candidates shall be called in order of merit. If a candidate is absent, he/she will lose priority. If such a candidate reports late and a seat is available at that time, he/she shall be considered for admission at that instant.

The candidate shall be considered for admission only if he/she has all the relevant certificates mentioned in this brochure (see list above).

2. If the information in the Application form does not match the certificates, the candidature will be canceled.

3. The Admission Committee reserves the right to re-verify the eligibility for admission as per the stipulated rules. If a candidate is not eligible, admission will not be offered.

4. Academic Fees Demand Draft *in favor of Director, VNIT, Nagpur, payable at Nagpur*, and one set of Xerox copies of all certificates shall be retained by the Academic Section. The candidate has to sign the admission acceptance letter.

5. Original GATE Score Card (If applicable) and TC are required to be deposited in the Institute on or before **4th September 2024**. Failure to which the admission shall be canceled.

6. An Admission Letter shall be issued to the candidate with instructions to be followed.

7. Hostel accommodation is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Important Note: Candidates will be eligible for a GATE scholarship (if applicable) as of their date of joining.

10 Cancellation of Admission and Refund of Fees

A candidate who has secured his/her admission may cancel it by submitting an application to the Director and requesting a refund of fees. Refer to the institute's website for the refund policy.

11 Conduct and Discipline

Students studying in the Institute who are found indulging in anti-national activities contrary to the provisions of acts and laws enforced by the Government or in any activity contrary to rules of discipline will be liable to be expelled by the Director of the Institute without any notice.

Candidates applying for admission against the seats reserved for backward classes (SC/ST/OBC/OM) should note that only those candidates who actually belong to the respective castes and communities will be eligible for admission under the reserved category.

If any of the statements made in the application form or any information supplied by the candidate in connection with his/her admission is later on, at any stage, found to be false or incorrect, his/her admission will be cancelled, fees forfeited, and he/she may be expelled from the Institute and prosecuted if deemed necessary.

All candidates seeking admission to M Tech programs in Engineering/Technology are required to give the following undertaking:

- A] I have read all the ordinances, rules & regulations for the current year (and as may be amended from time to time) and are acceptable to me. I have filled in this form of application for admission for the current year.
