- The Summer Term Courses shall be offered with the approval of Dean (Acd) / S 17.16 Director and the honorarium payable for conduct of Summer Term Courses shall be Rs. 10,000/-.
- As regards registration in Interdisciplinary Board of Studies it was resolved to S 17.19 place the item afresh in next Senate meeting, for deliberation and discussion.

The Heads of the Department may review the other factors pertaining to M.Tech. Project Reports and forward the suggestions for consideration of Senate in the next meeting.

4. In-semester evaluation of the Audit Course shall be at the discretion of student / reference hear transferred to teacher.

S 18.05 To consider the time period for submission of Ph.D. / M.Tech. research / M.Arch. Research thesis.

The Senate resolved that the period of submission of Ph.D. shall be six months from giving pre-submission seminar. However, if 6 monthly seminar scheduled before submission of the thesis, the scholar will not be exempted from giving the seminar.

S 18.06 To consider revised attendance rules.

The Senate resolved that the minimum attendance shall be 75%. The evaluation shall be same for theory and practical classes. It was further resolved that the actual number of attendance out of total number of classes conducted, shall be shown on the grade card as against percentage.

S 18.08 To consider recruitment qualifications for teaching posts in VNIT.

The Chairman apprised the Senate that the Institution is required to frame its own Recruitment Rules. The Senate requested all the Heads of the Departments to prepare a concrete proposal in consideration of norms to all the departments with reference to,

- (1) Educational qualifications, years of experience in particular cadre, age criteria etc. should be same across all academic departments.
- (2) Number of publications, quality of work, guidance to Ph.D. scholars and M.Tech. Programmes shall be decided by the individual department.
- (3) Norms of R&D activities, testing consultancy work, patents, writing of books and administrative experience etc. will be decided by individual department.
- (4) The recruitment norms for direct appointment shall not be lower than that of CAS.

The proposal shall be forwarded to the Director by 15th January 2010.

S 18.09 To consider induction of new M.Tech. programme in Construction Technology & Management.

S 18.10 Induction of new PG programme in Architecture.

S 18.11 Induction of M.Tech. programme in Power Electronics & Drives.
