S 20.05 Inclusion of new subjects.

i) Department of Mechanical Engineering.

Senate approved the merger of "Reliability Engineering" and "Maintenance Engineering" as one subject i.e. "Reliability & Maintenance Engineering" (MEL425), and introduction of new elective titled "Die & Mould Design" (MEL434) to be offered to UG/PG programme as proposed by the Deptt. of Mechanical Engineering. The approval is subject to consent of the Board of Studies.

ii) Department of Humanities.

Senate approved the introduction of new courses viz. Labour Economics & Industrial Relations (HUL406) and India Studies (HUL407) and suggested to increase the number of text books.

iii) Introduction of new electives in M.Tech. (Construction Technology & Management) programme and UG program run by Department of Civil Engineering.

Senate approved the proposal of Civil Engineering Department to introduce

- (a) i. Maintenance and Rehabilitation of structures (CEL 557)
- ii. Pre-cast and Composite Structure (CEL 560)
 - iii. Risk Analysis and Decision Making (CEL 561)
 - iv. Sustainable Construction Engineering (CEL 562)

for M.Tech. (Constitution Technology & Management Programme). However, the subject Risk Analysis and Decision Making (CEL 561) can be Departmental Elective for other branches.

- (b) Introduction of new elective CEL 368 : Advanced hydraulics (3-1-0=8) to B.Tech. (Civil) at 3rd year level.
- S 20.06 To consider Credit Courses for PhD and M.Arch. (By Research).

Senate approved the credit course for Ph.D. as proposed by Deptt. of Architecture.

As regards M.Arch. (by Research), Senate suggested the HoD Architecture to re-submit a comprehensive proposal in next meeting of the Senate.

S 20.07 Course mapping for M.Tech. (Materials Engg.).

Senate approved the mapping and scheme for M.Tech. (Materials Engg.) as approved by Board of Studies.

- S 20.08 Ratification of courses offered to PhD scholars by Department of Physics.
