Senate further resolved that the Institute should opt out of the DASA scheme from the

academic year 2012-13 and onwards due to academic reasons and severe infrastructural

constraints.

would be free to register for "DE" courses of their respective departments in lieu of Open

Courses, all other credit requirements remaining unchanged.
