BWC 22.03 To approve the tender for construction of additional floor on Estate Maintenance Building.

BWC approved the tender of M/s Ideal Construction Co.

BWC 22.04 To approve the detailed estimates of extension of Cricket pavilion.

The BWC noted the observations of representatives of State and Central PWD (Electrical Wing) and deferred the matter till next meeting with a request to Officer I/c Electrical Maint. to re-submit the proposal with details viz. scope of work, requisite drawings, specifications, makes etc. and in compliance with the suggestions received from Central PWD.

BWC 22.05 To consider the request of CPWD to release the excess amount.

The CPWD has requested VNIT to release ₹ 3 Crores for excess quantity work and escalation. The Committee heard the views of State & Central PWD representatives but, nevertheless decided to write to the CPWD that the amount of ₹58 Lakhs (on account of escalation caused due to delay on the part of the CPWD in starting the work) should be waived. Remaining amount of ₹ 242 Lakhs on account of excess quantity work can be released immediately. The correspondence that may be received from CPWD regarding waiver of ₹ 58 Lakhs will be placed before the Finance Committee of the Institute for consideration.
