The Committee discussed the agenda and resolved as under;

BWC 31.01 To note the minutes of the 30th meeting of the Building and Works Committee held on 28th June 2013.

The recommendations of the 30th BWC were confirmed.

BWC 31.02 Action taken report on the minutes of the 30th meeting of the BWC held on 28th June 2013.

The BWC noted the action taken report and observed the following:

- A. As regards item No. 30.07 the detailed estimates for furnishing of Professor and Associate Professors quarters is confirmed as justified.
- B. While deliberating sewage treatment plant for re-use of treated waste water vide 30.08(A) it was recommended to have two way pumping system for all new buildings and work can be undertaken in two phases and in first phase planning should be made for 5000 population.

BWC 31.03 Construction of Boys hostel.

The BWC approved the proposal with suggestion to work out triple occupancy in all hostel blocks including girls hostel.

BWC 31.04 Mega mess for Boys.

The BWC approved the proposal.

BWC 31.05 Mega mess for Girls Hostel + recreation facility.

BWC approved the proposal with the suggestion that the recreation facility can be converted into mess in future, if recommend.

BWC 31.08 To approve the tender for the work of Civil work at ground floor of transit accommodation building at VNIT, Nagpur.

BWC approved the proposal as the estimated cost is justified.

BWC 31.09 Detailed estimates of Construction of sump and pump house near ESR in Hostel Premises.

BWC approved the proposal.

BWC 31.10 Modification in construction of lecture hall complex.

BWC approved the proposal.

BWC 31.11 Any other item with permission of the Chair.

Master Plan of the Institute.

Dr. R. K. Ingle, Professor in Structural Engineering made a presentation of master plan of the campus wherein the need of going for high rise buildings to accommodate increased strength of students, faculty, staff and required infrastructure of 20 academic departments was discussed. The BWC approved in principle the master plan with appreciation and resolved that the present construction activities which are not integrated with master plan to be withhold. Accordingly, it was recommended to stall the further processing of construction of (1) extension of departments of Physics, Chemistry and MEC buildings, (2) extension of Electronics Department and recreation facility for HB No. 3 & 4 and (3) extension of Computer Science Building.

Requirement of all the above buildings will be accommodated in single block to be constructed as per master plan with an estimated cost of Rs. 75 Crores.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
