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2) 10% of the Basic plus grade pay plus DA of the employees-

The minimum of (1) and (2) of the above will be charged as license fee per month for the occupant of Professor and Associate Professor quarters respectively.

Provided that, in case the occupant has his/her basic plus grade pay plus DA below the respective pay (of Associate Professor/Professor as applicable in the most recent RRs: currently as in four tier system), the license fee shall be fixed as follows. For the occupants of Professor and Associate Professors quarters, any occupant is required to pay minimum license fee as per amount based on the minimum basic pay plus grade pay of the respective scale plus DA as applicable. This would be revised upwards from time to time with a change of pay and DA.

Resolution: The action taken for 31st Finance Committee meeting is confirmed with the following remarks.

For the item No. 31.04.01: A detail calculation as per FR/SR rules for charging license fees for new quarters with 6% capital asset and/or in accordance with the President's interest rate would be applicable.

F32.03 Foreign travel expenses under Cumulative Professional Development Allowance (CPDA) for Faculty.

The faculty travelling abroad for attending the conferences and technical discussions are permitted to meet the expenses under CPDA.

Due to escalation in the travelling cost the present limit of Rs.1.5 Lacs is not sufficient for booking the expenses of their foreign travel. Therefore, it is proposed to increase the limit for expenses to the faculty travelling under Cumulative Professional Development Allowance to Rs. 2.5 lakhs due to enhancement of foreign travel cost in a block of three years.

Finance Committee is requested to approve.

Resolution: Finance Committee approved the item and suggested that the Institute should take due care while approving the expenditure as per the limits permitted by Institute rules.

F 32.04 Initiating New Construction activity academic block, students hostels for boys and girls and mega messes for boys and girls.

As approved in 36th BWC vide item no. 36.03 and as per approval of BoG vide item no 41.04, then subsequent discussions in 36th BWC meeting dated 12th Nov. 2014, the MoU has been signed with NBCC Ltd. for initiating New Construction activity of academic block, students hostels for boys and girls and mega messes for boys and girls.

The 15% (i.e. Rs. 31.58 Crores) of the total cost has to be released to NBCC Ltd. for initiated this new construction activity. It is proposed to release Rs. 15 Crores as a first installment to commence the work i.e. (50 % approx. of 15 % amount)

Finance Committee is requested to deliberate and accord the approval.

Resolution: Finance Committee approved the item and suggested that the Institute should request MHRD for an early release of the funds as per schedule for commencement of work.
