
Dr. A P. Patil Dean(SW) could not attend meeting.

The following points were discussed

1. The committee browsed most of the files (As placed before the committee) to be sent to the Director for Approval.
2. Students who have completed more than six years and not completed credit requirement for award of degree are again applying to consider their cases. As per the Senate recommendation, a committee was constituted which recommended appropriate line of action, and subsequently approved by the Director. It is opined that the recommendations of the committee stands and no further application from such students will be entertained.
3. It was proposed to prepare an address of Director for 15th August 2012 and Dean (FW) will read it after getting it confirmed by Director.
4. It was decided to distribute the old bags (around 13) to ex and present Deans, Registrar, Director and coordinator of NBA.
5. It was opined by all that Electrical and Civil maintenance should pro-actively check problems in various departments and hostels, try to solve minor one and prepare a list of major repairs to be taken up. It was informed by Dr S S Bhat, FIC(Electrical maintenance) the he has already started this activity. Dean (P&D) is requested to do the needful for similar check from civil maintenance point of view.
6. A note from Dr. S S Bhat, Chairman (Smart card Committee) regarding issue of duel frequency cards instead of proximity card is discussed. It was suggested to start the activity with proximity card as approved. A detailed proposal shall be prepared for duel frequency cards and submitted to the Director for approval.
