THE NATIONAL INSTITUTES OF TECHNOLOGY (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2012

No. 28 of 2012

An Act to amend the National Institutes of Technology Act, 2007.

[7th June, 2012]

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the National institutes of Technology (Amendment) Short title and Act, 2012.

An Act to declare certain Institutions of Technology, Science, Education and research to be Institutions of National Importance and to provide for instructions and research in branches of engineering, technology, management, education, sciences and arts and for the advancement of learning and dissemination of knowledge in such branches and for certain other matters connected with such institutions.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty eight Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

CHAPTER I PRELIMINARY

- (1) This Act may be called the National Institutes of Technology (Amendment) Act, 2012.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the Central Government may, by notification in the official gazette, appoint.

Declaration of certain Institutions as Institutions of national importance

Whereas the objects of the institutions mentioned in the First

Schedule and Second Schedule are such as to make them institutions of national importance, it is hereby declared that each such institute is an institution of national importance.

Definitions

- In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, -
- (a) "Board", in relation to any Institute, means the Board of Governors thereof;
- (b) "Chairperson" means the Chairperson of the Board;
- (c) "corresponding Institute", in relation to a society mentioned in column (2) of the First Schedule and Second Schedule, means the Institute as specified in column (3) of the Schedule;
- (d) "Council" means the Council established under sub-section (1) of section 30 or Sub-Section (1) of Section 30A, as the case may be;
- (e) "Deputy Director", in relation to any Institute, means the Deputy Director thereof;
- (f) "Director", in relation to any Institute, means the Director

thereof;

- (g) "Institute" means any of the Institutions mentioned in column(3) of the First Schedule and Second Schedule;
- (h) "Notification" means a notification published in the Official Gazette;
- (i) "prescribed" means prescribed by rules made under this Act;
- "Registrar", in relation to any Institute, means the Registrar thereof;
- (k) "Schedule" means the First Schedule and Second Schedule annexed to the Act;
- "Senate", in relation to any Institute, means the Senate thereof;
- (m) "society" means any of the societies registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and mentioned in column (2) of the First Schedule and Second Schedule 21 of 1860;
- (n) "Statutes" and "Ordinances", in relation to any Institute, mean the Statutes and Ordinances of that Institute made under this Act.

Chapter II THE INSTITUTES

- 4. (1) Each of the Institutes mentioned in column (3) of the First Incorporation Schedule and Second Schedule shall be a body corporate of Institutes having perpetual succession and a common seal and shall, by its name, sue and be sued.
- (2) The body corporate constituting each of the said Institutes shall consist of a Chairperson, a Director and other members of the Board for the time being of the Institute.
- 5. On and from the commencement of this Act, -
- any reference to a society in any law, other than this Act, or in any contract or other instrument shall be deemed as a reference to the corresponding Institute;
- (b) all property, movable and immovable, of or belonging to a society shall vest in the corresponding Institute;
- (c) all the rights and liabilities of a society shall be transferred to, and be the rights and liabilities of, the corresponding Institute; and
- (d) every person employed by a society immediately before

such commencement shall hold his office or service in the corresponding Institute for the same tenure, at the same remuneration and upon the same terms and conditions and with the same rights and privileges as to pension, leave, gratuity, provident fund and other matters as he would have held if this Act had not been passed, and shall continue to do so unless and until his employment is terminated or until such tenure, remuneration and terms and conditions are duly altered by the Statutes:

Provided that if the alteration so made is not acceptable to such employee, his employment may be terminated by the Institute in accordance with the terms of contract with the employee or, if no provision is made therein in this behalf, on payment to him by the Institute of compensation equivalent to three months' remuneration in the case of permanent employees and one month's remuneration in the case of other employees.

Powers of the Institutes

6

- (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, every Institute shall exercise the following powers and perform the following duties, namely: -
- (a) to provide for instruction and research in such branches of engineering and technology, management, education, sciences and arts, as the Institute may think fit, and for the advancement of learning and dissemination of knowledge in such branches;
- (b) to hold examinations and grant degrees, diplomas and other academic distinctions or titles;
- (c) to confer honorary degrees or other distinctions;
- (d) to fix, demand and receive fees and other charges;
- (e) to establish, maintain and manage halls and hostels for the residence of students;
- (f) to supervise and control the residence and regulate the discipline of students of the Institute and to make arrangements for promoting their health, general welfare and cultural and corporate life;
- (g) to provide for the maintenance of units of the National Cadet Corps for the students of the Institute;
- (h) to institute academic and other posts with the prior approval of the Central Government, and to make appointments thereto excluding the Director;
- to frame Statutes and Ordinances and to alter, modify or

rescind the same;

- to deal with any property belonging to or vested in the Institute in such manner as the Institute may deem fit for advancing the objects of the Institute;
- (k) to receive gifts, grants, donations or benefactions from the Government and to receive bequests, donations and transfers of moveable or immovable properties from testators, donors or transferors, as the case may be;
- to co-operate with educational or other institutions in any part of the world having objects wholly or partly similar to those of the Institute by exchange of teachers and scholars and generally in such manner as may be conducive to their common objects;
- (m) to institute and award fellowships, scholarships, exhibitions prizes and medals; and
- (n) to undertake consultancy in the areas or disciplines relating to the Institute; and
- (o) to do all such things as may be necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects of the Institute.
- (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1), an Institute shall not dispose of in any manner any immovable property without the prior approval of the Central Government.
- 7. (1) Every Institute shall be open to persons of either sex and of Institutes to be whatever race, creed, caste or class, and no test or condition open to all shall be imposed as to religious belief or profession in races, creeds admitting or appointing members, students, teachers or and classes. workers or in any other connection whatsoever.
- (2) No bequest, donation or transfer of any property shall be accepted by any Institute, which in the opinion of the Council involves conditions or obligations opposed to the spirit and object of this section.
- All teaching at each of the Institutes shall be conducted by or Teaching at in the name of the Institute in accordance with the Statutes Institute and Ordinances made in this behalf.

For the purpose of enabling the Institutes to discharge their functions efficiently under this Act, the Central Government may, after due appropriation made by Parliament by law in this behalf, pay to every Institute in each financial year such sums of money and in such manner as it may think fit.

Fund of the Institute

- 21. (1) Every Institute shall maintain a Fund to which shall be credited,-
- (a) all moneys provided by the Central Government;
- (b) all fees and other charges received by the Institute;
- all moneys received by the Institute by way of grants, gifts, donations, benefactions, bequests or transfers; and
- (d) all moneys received by the Institute in any other manner or from any other source.
- (2) All moneys credited to the Fund of every Institute shall be deposited in such banks or invested in such manner as the Institute may, with the approval of the Central Government, decide.
- (3) The Fund of every Institute shall be applied towards meeting the expenses of the Institute including expenses incurred in the exercise of its powers and discharge of its duties under this Act.

Accounts and Audit

22. (1) Every Institute shall maintain proper accounts and other relevant records and prepare an annual statement of accounts including the balance-sheet, in such form as may be specified by notification, by the Central Government in

- consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India.
- (2) The accounts of every Institute shall be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India and any expenditure incurred by him in connection with such audit shall be payable by the Institute to the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India.
- (3) The Comptroller and Auditor-General of India and any person appointed by him in connection with the audit of the accounts of any Institute shall have the same rights, privileges and authority in connection with such audit as the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India has in connection with the audit of the Government accounts, and, in particular, shall have the right to demand the production of books, accounts, connected vouchers and other documents and papers and to inspect the offices of the Institute.

The accounts of every Institute as certified by the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India or any other person appointed by him in this behalf together with the audit report thereon shall be forwarded annually to the Central Government and that Government shall cause the same to be laid before each House of Parliament in accordance with such procedure as may be laid by the Central Government.
