BWC 60.04	To recommend Bill of Quantity for Supply, Erection, testing and Commissioning of HT/LT Cable and related work for VNIT campus to FC.
	The Associate Dean(Electrical Works) has submitted the proposal for Supply, Erection, testing and Commissioning of HT/LT Cable for VNIT campus as the Electrical Network in VNIT is very old (about 40 years) and needs replacement. The total bill of quantity is of Rs.3,68,95,545/- (Estimated amount). Annexure-II.
	The expenditure will be debited to OH-35. Hence, BWC is requested to recommend Bill of Quantity for Supply, Erection, testing and Commissioning of HT/LT Cable and related work for VNIT campus to the Finance Committee.

Resolution: BWC in principal recommends Bill of Quantity for Supply, Erection, Testing and Commissioning of HT/LT Cable and related work for VNIT campus to the Finance Committee and the institute should re-estimate the amount as per the CSR rates.

Action Taken Report: The re-estimation as per the CSR rates has been carried out. **(Annexure-II).** The Re-estimated total bill of quantity is of Rs.3,32,32,500/- (Plus GST as applicable)

The Finance Committee is requested to recommend Bill of Quantity for Supply, Erection, testing and Commissioning of HT/LT Cable and related work for VNIT campus to BoG.

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BWC 60.05

To recommend the proposal of Construction for Health Centre to FC.

The existing Health Centre is in dilapidated state and space is very small for the increased strength of the students. This building is more than 40 years old and has load bearing structure. Most of the walls have developed big cracks and floors of the various rooms are settled down. Looking into current COVID- 19 pandemic, it is proposed to dismantle the existing old structure and construct new frame structure of G.F.+ F.F. The structural design of this building will be for G+3. The proposed built up area for the building is 700 Sq. M. i.e. 350 Sq. M. at Ground Floor and 350 Sq. M. at First Floor.

The schematic plan of the health centre is attached and first stage estimate is prepared as per Maharashtra P.W.D. construction rate per Sq. M. which is approximately 225 Lakhs. If approved the expenditure will be debited to OH-35 (Annexure-III).

The Building and Works Committee is requested to recommend the proposal to the Finance Committee.

Resolution : The Building and Works Committee recommends the proposal of Construction for Health Centre to the Finance Committee.

Action Taken Report: The detail estimate is prepared on basis of SSR of state PWD 2019-2020. The estimated cost of Civil and Electrical work is Rs.217 Lacs plus GST.(Annexure-III)

Hence, the Finance Committee is requested to recommend proposal of Construction for Health Centre and related work for VNIT campus to BoG.

Resolution: FC recommended the proposals of 60th BWC regarding Bill of Quantity for Supply, Erection, testing and Commissioning of HT/LT Cable and related work for VNIT campus and Construction for Health Centre and related work for VNIT campus to BoG, for its approval.

Institute has unspent balance of Rs.15.18 Cr under OH-35, carried forward from previous year 2019-20. Out of this, there is committed expenditure of around Rs.10.15 Cr towards various items, which are delayed due to COVID-19. Cost of present proposals (incl. GST) is Rs.6.15 Cr. Out of this, Rs.5.03 Cr will be met from unspent balance of last year and Rs.1.12 Cr can be met from allocation of 2020-21. Other planned works under OH-35 will be undertaken after reviewing actual funds received, during the current year 2020-21.

F 62.04 To recommend the fees to be charged (Academic and Hostels etc.) for the VNIT students, under various heads, during the Academic Session Winter 2020.

As per the Deans meeting held on July 29, 2020 it is proposed to charge fees (Academic and Hostels etc.) for the students, under various heads during the Academic Session Winter 2020. (Annexure-IV)

The Finance Committee is requested to recommend the same to BoG for its approval.

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Resolution: FC recommended the fees to be charged (Academic and Hostels etc.) for the VNIT students, under various heads, during the Academic Session Winter 2020 to BoG, for its approval.

F 62.05 To recommend the proposal regarding construction of VNIT Convention Centre.

It is proposed to construct VNIT Convention Centre for organizing International Conference, National Conference, Short Term Training Programme, Faculty Development Programme and National level students activities such as Aarohi, Consortium and technical festivals which are conducted throughout the academic session and also during vacations. The present strength of B.Tech., M.Tech., Ph.D. students is around 5000.

The current infrastructure is very old i.e. 40 years old and which is inadequate for conduct of Institute Convocation, International/National conferences. The proposal regarding construction of Convention Centre, VNIT Nagpur is enclosed in **Annexure-V**.

This ultramodern Convention Centre will have a capacity to accommodate 2500 persons in the Auditorium and additional two halls each of the capacity 100 and 200 to carry out short term training programmes, group discussions, small events of National and International forums. This Convention Centre will also have Facilities like VIP lounge, Discussion area and Poster Presentation area etc. The approximate cost of this Convention Centre will be Rs. 68.00 Crores. If approved, IRG funds of the Institute will be utilized for this Convention Centre.

The Finance Committee is requested to recommend the proposal of construction of VNIT Convention Centre to BoG.

Resolution: The Finance Committee recommends the proposal of construction of VNIT Convention Centre to BoG. The Institute should revisit the item in connection with the seating capacity to accommodate persons in the proposed Convention Centre and sent the DPR to Ministry of Education, accordingly.

F 62.06 To recommend remittance of the interest earned on Govt. grants to the Consolidated Fund of India to BoG for its approval.

The Institute is in receipt of MHRD letter F.No.33-1/2019-TS.III (Pt.3) dated 01-01-2020, on the subject cited (Annexure-VIA).

It is informed vide above letter, that in view of rule 230(8) of General Financial Rules, 2017 "all interests or other earnings against Grants in aid or advances (other than reimbursement) released to any Grantee institution should be mandatorily remitted to consolidated fund of India immediately after finalization of accounts. Such advance should not be allowed to be adjusted against future releases".

Accordingly, Institute has worked out interest to be remitted to consolidated fund of India, considering unspent balance of Grant-in-aid on monthly basis. Interest to be remitted for F.Y. 2019-20 works out to Rs.38,92,341 /-. The calculation sheet is enclosed at **Annexure-VIB**.

The interest is calculated @ 4% of unspent balance of Grant-in-aid on monthly basis (considering the fact that grant-in-aid is either kept in current account to meet day to day expenses or invested in FDRs, in case of more balance available as compared to routine fund requirement).

In view of the above, FC is requested to recommend remittance of interest earned on govt. grants amounting to Rs.38,92,341 /- for F.Y. 2019-20 to the Consolidated Fund of India, to BoG for its approval.
