Standard Operating Procedure

For students availing hostel facility

1. Contact Hostel Section about your travel plan. The exact mechanism of contacting (Google form link / email) will be specified in the hostel notice board on the institute web-site.
2. Before starting the journey, make sure you are fully vaccinated and recovered from the effects of vaccination, if any. Keep a copy of vaccination certificate with you. Vaccination certificate, is mandatory for arriving at the campus.
3. When you arrive at VNIT campus, report to the hostel section.
4. You will be allotted a room, if not allotted already, and you will have to undergo medical screening in the health center of VNIT.
5. You will stay isolated in your room, till the health center clears your case.
6. You will have to comply with all the instructions and directives of VNIT Health Center, in case you are detected RTPCR +ve while on campus.
7. Whenever your case is cleared by the health center, you have to report to your department and faculty advisor.
8. You can start attending classes by following all the COVID related norms in the campus.

For students NOT availing hostel facility

1. Before reporting to the department, make sure you are fully vaccinated and recovered from the effects of vaccination, if any.
2. When you report to your department, you must have certificate of full vaccination.
3. You can start attending the classes by following all the COVID related norms in the campus.

Once on campus, all the students will have to comply with COVID related norms issued from time to time, by the institute and the local authorities. Frequent RTPCR tests may have to be done as directed by local authorities.
