Eligibility Criteria for being Member of the Student Council

A. General

4. He should not be holding any administrative post offered to students like Senior Prefect.

- 5. He should not have engaged in any illegal activities in the Institute and should not have been punished for indiscipline/misconduct/misbehavior.
- 6. He/she should be capable to take new and sound initiatives, should have courage to raise right issues and discourage negative issues.
- 7. He/she should be removed from the council if he/she is found guilty of any misconduct.

B. Specific

Selection will be based on ideas presented during interview. Interview will focus on assessing leadership and managerial abilities of the candidate.
- 2. P.G. Academic Affairs Secretary: He/she should have sound knowledge of academic policies of institute, should have passion for academic excellence. His/her selection will be solely on ideas presented during interview.
- 3. U.G. Academic Affairs Secretary: He/she should have sound knowledge of academic policies of institute, should have passion for academic excellence. His/her selection will be solely on ideas presented during interview.
- Magazine and Literary Affairs Secretary: He/she should have participated in literary activities 4. including managing / editing one or section of VNIT Magazine. His/her selection will be based on ideas presented during interview.
- Training & Placement: She/he should have coordinated training and placement at departmental 5. level, or have adequate knowledge of training and placement policies of different companies. He/she should be able to convince companies about credentials of VNIT students and should be able to advise students accordingly.
- 6. Technical Affairs Secretary: He/she should have sound technical knowledge, should have organized or participated in technical fests and should have been actively involved in managing Technical Activities in the Institute.
- 7. Sports Secretary: He/she should be a sportsperson, represented Institute and should have been involved in managing sports activities in the Institute.
- 8. Cultural Secretary: He/she should have participated in cultural events and organized cultural events. He/she should be excellent in at least one item or one musical instrument.
- 9. PG Sports Secretary & Cultural Affairs Secretary: He/she should be a sportsperson. He/she should have participated in cultural events, represented institute and should have been involved in managing sports and cultural activities in the institute. Selection will be based on ideas presented during interview.

10. Ladies Representative: She should have a balanced personality, should be conversant with the rules & regulations of the Institute and should have been love and passion for the Institute. Selection will be based on ideas presented during interview. Interview will focus on checking leadership and managerial abilities in the candidates.

11. Hostel Affairs Secretary (Boys): He should be a hosteller and having experience of staying in hostel and a sound knowledge about functioning of hostels and hostel committees. Selection will be

based on ideas presented during interview.
